ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS

- 3. Date of Birth Block. Cardidates from between <u>07 July 1997</u> and <u>20 December 2000</u> (both days inclusive) are eligible to appear in the Recruitment Raily.
- 4. Educational Qualification.
- (a) For Group 'Y' (Non-Technical) Medical Assistant Trade. Candidate should have passed Intermediate / 10+2 / Equivalent Examination with Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English with a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in English.
- (b) For Group 'Y' (Non-Technical) (Auto Tech, GTI & IAF(P) Trades):- Candidate should have passed Intermediate / 10+2 / Equivalent Examination in any stream/subjects approved by Central / State Education Boards with minimum 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in English.

- 5. <u>Domicile Requirement.</u> To be eligible to appear in the rally at 4 ASC (Near Paita Gate), Air Force Station Barrackpore, 24 Paragnas (North), West Bengal 743122, the conditates are required to satisfy the following conditions:

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 10. Tenure & Training. Enrolment is for an initial period of 20 years extendable up to the age of 57 years (subject to service conditions). Initially candidates will be sent for a Joint Basic Phase Training (JBPT) at Basic Training institute, Belagavi (Karnataka). On successful completion of JBPT, candidates will be sent for trade training of specified duration. Training is however fable to be terminated at any time if the trainee fails to achieve the required standards in academics, profession, physical fitness and discipline or is found to be medically unlit. AFTER SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF TRAINING, THE AIRMEN WILL BE DEPLOYED ON GROUND BASED JOBS AS PER THEIR ALLOTTED TRADE. ALLOTTED TRADE WILL NOT BE CHANGED ON CANDIDATE'S REQUEST ON ANY GROUNDS.
- 11. Pay & Allowances. During training, a stipend of Rs. 11,4007-per month will be peid. On completion of training the starting gross emoluments at the minimum of scale of pay including Grade Pay, Military Service Pay (MSP), and Dearness Allowance (DA) will be Rs 23,5357-per month approximately) which, in subsequent years, may rise as per the career progression of the individual.
- 12. Other allowances such as Transport Allowance, Composite Personal Maintenance Allowance (CPMA), Leave Ration Allowance (LRA), Children Education Allowance, Family Planning Allowance, HRA etc. are also admissible to airmen. Note. The above pay 8 allowances are under revision by 7° Central Pay Commission.
- 13. - (a) Medical Assistant. Operating as a Medical Assistant, you are made familiar with mursing and first-aid. You are also involved in management of medical stores, dispensaries and ward supervision.
- (b) Automobile Technician. As an Automobile Technician you will drive all types of light, medium and heavy automobiles, load carriers and specialist vehicles like cranes, towing tractors, fork lifters etc., subject to service exigencies. You will also carry out minor repairs, day to day maintenance and basic level servicing of the common user vehicles and specialist vehicles in the indian Air Force inventory.
- (c) Ground Training Instructor. As a Ground Training instructor, you will train personnel on drill, parade, handling of arms and physical exercise. You are also responsible for organizing and conducting all games and sports activities.
- (d) Indian Air Force (Police). As an indian Air Force (Police) your responsibilities involve assuming police duties and investigation of offerces. You are also in-charge of maintenance of security.
